It replicates the pace, pressure, and complexity of real-world intelligence operations.

Q: What career opportunities will this program prepare me for?

A: Graduates are prepared for roles including Intelligence Analyst, Threat Analyst, GSOC Analyst, Security Intelligence Specialist, and Open Source Intelligence Collector across government, military, non-profit/NGO, and private sector organizations.
